Practice Discipline with Love

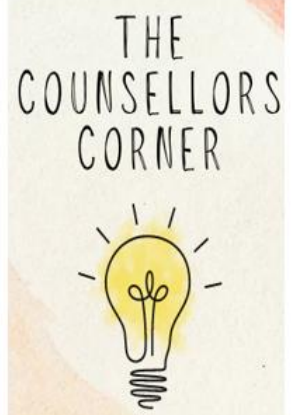
Discipline is important, but make sure it's done with love. Show that the rules are for their benefit.
