CHILDHOOD ANXIETY Support

Understanding Child Anxiety

Anxiety in children can appear as worry, fear, or physical symptoms like stomachaches and difficulty sleeping. Recognizing early signs can make a big difference.

COMMON SIGNS

- Avoiding school or activities
- Frequent headaches or stomach pain
- Irritability or restlessness
- Trouble concentrating
- Constant worry about small things

HOW PARENTS CAN HELP

- Listen with empathy
- Offer reassurance and patience
- Keep daily routines consistent
- Encourage relaxation and play
- Celebrate progress, even small steps

COPING SKILLS FOR KIDS

Practice deep breathing
Draw or write in a journal
Talk to a trusted adult
Stay active with fun exercise
Use positive self-talk daily
