COLD WEATHER GUIDELINES

Including Wind Chill Factors

Temperatures of -29 and above:

Students are expected to be outdoors at recess

Temperatures of -30 to -35:

Students are encouraged to get fresh air, however, remaining outdoors is optional

Temperatures of -36 and below:

Students will not be allowed outdoors

Please ensure that your children are dressed appropriately for the weather and that they remember to bring toques, mitts and ski pants
