- Please limit Halloween treats in lunches to 2 treat items.


BACK TO SCHOOL INFO:

- KINDERGARTEN SCHEDULE
- o Day 1, 3, 5 on the school calendar
- ♥ Parents, please ensure all children dress in layers as the fall weather begins. We ask that each student have a non-marking indoor and a good outdoor shoe to wear outside each day. Students are required to changes shoes from inside to outside at recess times.
- ♥ All students need a reusable water bottle for school to fill from the water coolers. These should be taken home daily for cleaning.
- ♥ If you need to get ahold of staff or leave a message for your child before the end of the school day, please call the school phone line. This is the best way to ensure your message is received. Please refrain from texting your child's teacher, as personal phones are not readily available during instructional time.

*Communication is important between home and school. PLEASE check your child's AGENDA daily for messages. Parents are also encouraged to leave messages for teachers in the AGENDA as well. Teachers use this Agenda as a daily form of communicating information daily. Have your child show it to you every night. Please check the pocket at the front of the AGENDA for any notes sent home as well.

- *If your child will be absent or late any day, please contact the school with a note or a phone call so that teachers can be made aware of his/her absence.
- *Supervision of students by staff is provided starting at 8:40am am. Please ensure your children do not arrive prior to supervision time.
- * Mrs. Aglupos is in the office Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday mornings and phones will be answered by her. In her absence we have an answering system, so please leave a message and it will be checked at the next available break.
